


Port Report

Jan spent 16 years with the HRI as Director of Catering. She also managed their Beer and Wine program, earning national acclaim for her Gorge focused wine list for five consecutive years. This will mean more weddings, birthday parties, reunions to increase revenue from our beautiful facilities. This remodel is set to be completed in mid-April and will facilitate more use for private events as well as public. This is the first step in a 4 year improvement plan for the Pavilion.

Public Boat Launch Closed 1 Week

The Port has secured grant funding from the Oregon State Marine Board to improve the public boat launch located in the Cascade Locks Marine Park. The tow ramp will be extended 9 feet in order to allow a safer entry into the river for boat trailers. The in-water work began February 22nd, requiring the closure of one or both sides of the launch for approximately one week. We are excited for the completion of this enhancement and the ongoing use for boaters.
