Park Dedications Honor Local Service

On Saturday, June 27th, a plaque was placed on the footbridge to Thunder Island to honor Gene Miller for his outstanding service to the Port. Mr. Miller was a Port employee for 19 years. His family was in attendance for the ceremony. Local metal artist Brad Lorang was commissioned to build a metal frame with sternwheeler detail for the plaque.

On that same day, a park bench was dedicated to residents Don and Gyda Haight, to acknowledge the significant contributions they have both made to the Port and greater Cascade Locks Community. Their volunteer service throughout the years includes Marine Park landscaping, community sailing program fundraising, local businesses support, serving on the Port Commission, and many other related activities.

Cruise Boat Docking in Locks


The Port has scheduled the docking of a small cruise boat in the historic locks and canal every Sunday between mid-April and mid-November. Fishers should plan accordingly.

Other Bridge of the Gods Safety Notes

The posted speed limit on the Bridge of the Gods is 15 MPH for all vehicles. There is no passing permitted on the Bridge of the Gods. Pedestrians and bicycles are allowed to cross the bridge for \$0.50. Pedestrians should walk single file along the railing, against traffic. Bridge customers should be courteous to all other bridge user types.
