


# Port Report



## **SOLD: TIB Buys Two Wa Na Pa Lots**

Thunder Island Brewing Co. (TIB) celebrated their third anniversary this October. The successful young brewery started in the Port's business incubator space at the west end of the Cascade Locks Marine Park. The business recently signed a purchase and sale agreement (PSA) with the Port for two vacant lots on Wa Na Pa Street, located between Jumpin' Jax Java and the old fire hall. TIB plans to develop an attractive new building space for their growing restaurant and brewing operation, projected to open by the end of 2018. In a related effort, the City of Cascade Locks Planning Commission recently approved a Conditional Use Permit submitted in partnership by the Port and TIB, allowing the brewery to remain in their current Marine Park location for two more years while they work swiftly to secure financing, designs, and permitting for their new development on Wa Na Pa.

## **New Facility Fees, Effective January 1**


Port staff perform a comprehensive review at the end of every busy season in the Marine Park in order to determine if the Port's fees are fair and competitive with comparable facilities throughout the region. On November 17<sup>th</sup> the Port Commission approved a revised package of fees recommended by staff, effective January 1<sup>st</sup>. In an effort to address peak demand and maintain lower rates for local residents, the new fee schedule is structured in tiers:

- 1) peak season vs. non-peak season
- 2) local vs. out of town customers
- 3) mid-week vs. weekend dates

Overall, the Port seeks to increase revenue from private party event rentals (weddings, reunions, baby showers, meetings, etc), in order to reduce reliance upon bridge toll revenue long term, and to pay for planned park improvements for all to enjoy.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) is planning an extended navigation lock closure to occur from December 12, 2016 through March 20, 2017. The 14-week long closure will affect all navigation locks operated by the USACE on the Columbia and Snake Rivers system; no river traffic will be able to pass during this time. #### **Public Boat Launch Closed 1 Week**

The Port has secured grant funding from the Oregon State Marine Board to improve the public boat launch located in the Cascade Locks Marine Park. The tow ramp will be extended 9 feet in order to allow a safer entry into the river for boat trailers. The in-water work will occur in mid-January, requiring the closure of one or both sides of the launch for approximately one week. The exact closure dates will be based on weather, to be announced as soon as possible.
